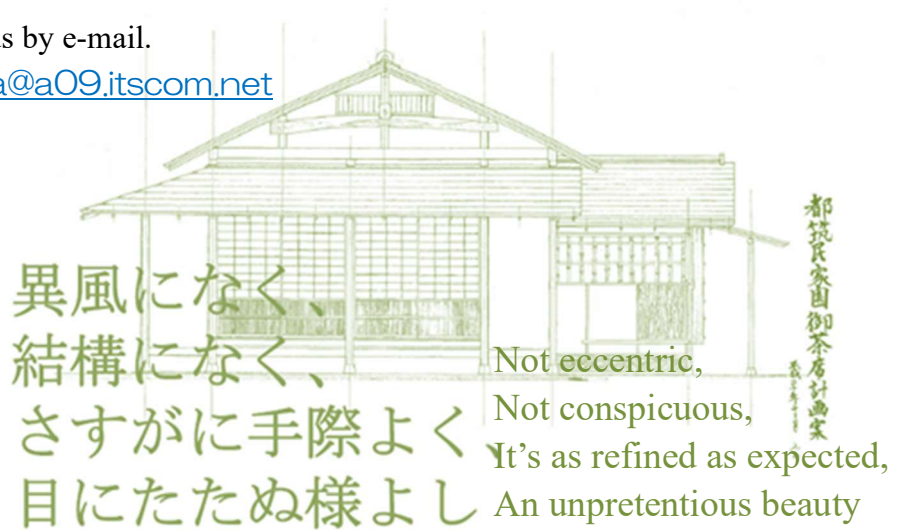


Tea ceremony lessons for foreigners
